    - ✓ **Prenatal Yoga**
    - ✓ **Restorative Yoga**
5. Add new slide with **Title and Content Layout**.
  - a. Add the title: **Yoga Diagram**
  - b. Insert any **SmartArt** diagram with **4 components**. (0.5 mark)
  - c. Copy the previous bulleted text in each object. (0.5 mark)
6. Add the following speaker note to slide (1):  
**WWW.yoga.com** (1 mark)
7. Add new slide with **Title and Content Layout**. (1 mark)
  - a. Add the title: **The percentage of usage the difference type of computer**

b. Create Pie Chart according to the below table information

Type of Yoga	the percentage of Play
Iyengar Yoga	40%
Anusara Yoga	25%
Prenatal Yoga	15%
Restorative Yoga	20%

8. Add **Aspect** design template for slide (2). (1 mark)
9. Change the orientation of all slides to **portrait**. (0.5 mark)
  
10. Insert **updated date and time** as footer and apply it to all slide. (0.5 mark)
  
11. Change the **background** of all slides to **light Yellow**. (1 mark)
12. Add **Wipe** Effect as a Custom Animation to the Chart on slide (4). (1 mark)
  
13. Add slide transition as follows: (1 mark)
  - ❖ Slide (1): Shape
  - ❖ Slide (2): Uncover
  - ❖ Slide (3): Doors
  - ❖ Slide (4): Zoom
